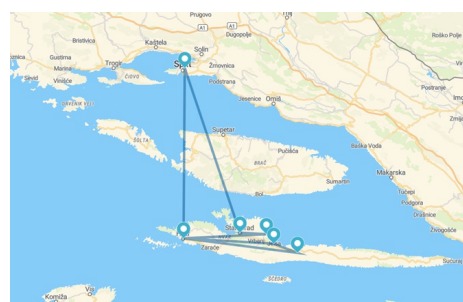




Croatia, 6 Days · Tailor-made by car

Hvar Island and Split's Route

This is a journey through centuries of history, attractive landscapes and some of Croatia's most magical corners, which will take you to the ancient city of Split and Hvar, one of the most stunning islands in the world. The jaw-dropping Dalmatian coast wins over even the most experienced traveller with its sensational beaches, exquisite cuisine, unique scenery and a vibrant and contagious Mediterranean spirit. Split is one of those cities whose history is worthy of a movie plot. In fact, the opulent Diocletian's Palace, the amazing complex declared a World Heritage Site, has been one of the main locations for the blockbusting TV series Game of Thrones. We'll round off our trip by touring the graceful island of Hvar, a natural paradise famous throughout Europe for its chic and exclusive atmosphere. Driving around Hvar is a real treat. Its 2,700 hours of sunshine a year, its beach clubs frequented by artists and celebrities, its white pebble beaches and pristine waters, its dense lavender-blanketed landscapes, its views out to an azure sea dotted with luxury yachts... all make it a truly unforgettable place. From Split, you can go on interesting trips to the ancient pirate town of Omiš, the ruins of Salona (Solin), or the charming medieval town of Trogir. Nature lovers will find a haven in the Krka National Park (trip from Split) or the idyllic Pakleni Islands (trip from Hvar).

● DAY 1 · CITY OF ORIGIN - SPLIT

Flight departure from the city of origin to Split and rental car pick-up.

Your adventure begins here!

Split is an ancient city dotted with monuments and unique traditions, built and preserved by its welcoming population over the past 1,700 years. We have all day today to wander around the amazing city and enjoy its cheerful Mediterranean spirit. With one of the most beautiful old quarters in Europe, the lively maze-like Diocletian's Palace complex each year attracts tourists from all corners of the world. Declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site along with part of the old quarter of the city, this gigantic royal complex is home to trendy bars, interesting art galleries and elegant courtyards. Besides the palace, the city entices travellers with beautiful coastal scenery, a lively promenade (Riva), chic avenues such as Marmontova and squares with Viennese charm such as Trg Republike... Climb up the steps to Marjan Hill.

The views from here are magnificent.

● DAY 2 · SPLIT AND SURROUNDINGS

More time to enjoy the beautiful destination of Split, Croatia's second-largest city and one of the most impressive architectural sites in the Mediterranean. Close to its historic quarter is Bačvice Bay where you can enjoy vibrant nightlife and one of the most popular city beaches. With the freedom granted by your rental car, you'll be able to choose from a range of interesting trips within easy reach of the city. Simply pick the one that most appeals to you! To the south, about 50 minutes' drive, you can visit the captivating town of Omiš, a former refuge for pirates that has now become a modern seaside resort. If you like diving, you'll be able to explore shipwrecks! If you prefer to explore the cultural roots of Croatia, set off to the ruins of Salona (Solin), the former capital of the Roman province of Dalmatia, located just 30 minutes away. Another option is to head north, in particular to the stunning medieval town of Trogir, an all-stone citadel declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. And for nature lovers, nothing better than an outing to the Krka National Park, one of the country's most beautiful eco-destinations. Overnight stay in Split.

● DAY 3 · SPLIT - HVAR (STARI GRAD - VRBOSKA - HVAR TOWN)

More time to explore the beautiful city of Split. Then we'll head down to the port to take the ferry from Split to Stari Grad on the beautiful island of Hvar. Please note that the crossing takes around 2 hours.

After arriving, we'll drive through stunning landscapes smelling of lavender, rosemary and pine, with views of virgin forests and pristine white-pebbled beaches. In Stari Grad we'll discover beautiful cultural and agricultural landscapes, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO, which have remained virtually unchanged since they were first colonised by the Ionian Greeks in the fourth century BC.

Onward with our route.

Our journey will then take us through picturesque villages such as Vrboska until we reach the gorgeous capital city of Hvar. Its lively atmosphere, its trail of historical landmarks and its vibrant nightlife have made it fashionable among domestic and international tourists. We recommend visiting the Cathedral of St. Stephen, the Historic Theatre, the Spanish Fortress, the Tvrdalj Palace, Fort Napoleon...

● DAY 4 · HVAR - JELSA - HUMAC - HVAR

And on with our adventure! This beautiful Adriatic island guards many secrets that are well worth unearthing. After wandering around the capital (Hvar), admire its beautiful azure blue bay, its harbour dotted with luxury yachts of the rich and famous, and the picturesque pier that stretches up to the main square. Then it's back on the road to explore the island at our own pace. Its small size, gentle slopes, 2,700 hours of sunshine a year, blue skies and Instagram-worthy landscapes are the perfect ingredients for unforgettable drives. We'll leave behind the beautiful image of cream-coloured stone houses and terracotta roofs from a summit dominated by the Spanish Fortress, and set out on an attractive route dotted with limestone houses, beautiful lavender-covered landscapes and a vast blue sea as far as the eye can see... Our itinerary features picturesque villages such as Jelsa and Humac. And if you want a break from the road and the bustle of Hvar Town to chill out on the beach for a day, just hop on a catamaran over to the Pakleni Islands. And throughout the trip you'll enjoy the excellent cuisine and wines with which the locals regale travellers! Don't forget to try the traditional sponge cake with spices or gingerbread biscuits. Simply, delicious!

● DAY 5 · HVAR - SPLIT

We bid farewell to this beautiful island, often ranked one of the most stunning in the world, which has brightened the lives of everyone from emperors like Diocletian to present-day celebrities. So, with a heavy heart, it's goodbye to its fusion of nature and architecture, with Gothic, Renaissance and Venetian features, to its Mediterranean beaches and coves, to its delicious cuisine, to its marina, and to its party atmosphere famous throughout Europe. Then we'll take the ferry from the port of Stari Grad back to the city of Split. There we'll finish off our trip by a last day strolling around its walled historic quarter, dotted with Gothic palaces, romantic pavement cafes and trendy restaurants.

Important remarks

- Driving through Croatia: Motorways in Croatia have tolls, which you have to pay for each individual stretch of road. For more information, you can contact the Croatian Embassy based in your country.
- Triple rooms in Europe are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far as possible.
- Check-in time at the hotel on the day of arrival depends on each establishment, but in no case will it be before 3:00 p.m., unless otherwise indicated.
- The proposed excursions and tours for each day are purely suggestions, as you can tailor the trip to suit your times, tastes and needs.
- A credit card is considered a guarantee, so sometimes you will need one for check-in at hotels.
- Hotels usually have cots available. Otherwise, babies will have to share a bed with an adult.
- To pick up your rental car, you'll need a credit (not debit) card in the name of the person who made the booking, who must also be the named driver of the vehicle.
- Consult the necessary documentation to enter the destinations visited and for transit in the countries where air stopovers are made.
