



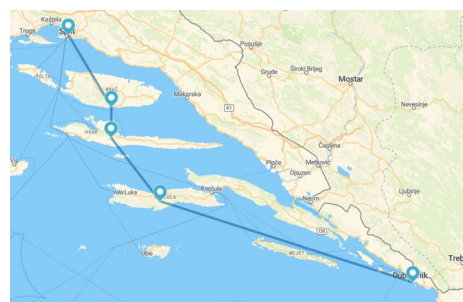
Croatia, 9 Days · Tailor-made

From Dubrovnik to Split with Korčula, Hvar and Brač by ferry

Travel details

● DAY 1 · CITY OF ORIGIN - DUBROVNIK

Day 1: Departure with destination Dubrovnik. Arrival and transfer to the hotel. Overnight stay.

● DAY 2 · DUBROVNIK - KORČULA

Includes : Breakfast

Day 2: Breakfast and transfer to the port of Dubrovnik, where we will board the catamaran or ferry to Korčula. This city is distinguished by its network of streets in the form of fish and preserved Gothic-Renaissance buildings. Among them, the Cathedral of San Marco stands out, with its rich interiors where the works of great Italian painters are kept. Legend also has it that Marco Polo was born in Korčula, so we recommend visiting the house where he was born, which is under the protection of the City council and which will soon become a museum. Arrival in Korčula and transfer to the hotel. Overnight stay.

● DAY 3 · KORČULA

Day 3: Breakfast. Free day. Overnight stay.

● DAY 4 · KORČULA - HVAR ISLAND

Includes : Breakfast

Day 4: Breakfast. At the pre-arranged time, transfer to the port and departure by catamaran or ferry to Hvar. This city has the oldest Dalmatia tourist centre, rich in interesting historical monuments. We recommend visiting the sixteenth century theatre, the Arsenal and the Central Square where the Cathedral is located and surrounded by numerous palaces built in different architectural styles. Its Franciscan Monastery is known for the collection of art works such as the "Last Supper" by Ingoli. Arrival in Hvar and transfer to the hotel. Overnight stay.

● DAY 5 · HVAR

Day 5: Breakfast. Free day. Overnight stay.

● DAY 6 · HVAR - BOL (BRAČ ISLAND)

Includes : Breakfast

Day 6: Breakfast. At the pre-arranged time, transfer to the port and departure by catamaran or ferry to Bol, on the island of Brač. This city, located on the south coast of the island, is a famous Croatian destination due to Zlatni Rat ("The Golden Cape"), a sandy beach in the shape of a tongue that penetrates half a kilometre into the sea and grows with the alluvial deposit of small gravel pebbles, changing its shape depending on the wind direction and waves. Bol is also a paradise for surfers because of the favorable wind that blows constantly. Arrival in Bol and transfer to the hotel. Overnight stay.

● DAY 7 · BOL

Includes : Breakfast

Day 7: Breakfast. Free day. Overnight stay.

● DAY 8 · BOL - SPLIT

Includes : Breakfast

Day 8: Breakfast. Transfer to the port and departure by catamaran or ferry to Split, a city with ancient history, built and preserved over 1700 years by its inhabitants. We can walk to the Diocletian Palace, the city's most precious monument as it is one of most important original structures in ancient architecture. Arrival in Split and transfer to the hotel. Overnight stay.

● DAY 9 · SPLIT - CITY OF ORIGIN

Day 9: Breakfast and transfer to the airport. Flight with destination the city of origin. Arrival. End of the trip and our services.

Important remarks

- Babies up to 2 years old in Croatia must share the bed with adults. In case you need a cot, or any other additional service, you will have to request it at each hotel and it will be a direct payment.
- Triple rooms in Europe are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far as possible.
- During congresses and special events, the confirmed hotels and other accommodations may be different to those indicated.
- During the circuit by Europe, only one suitcase and one carry-on bag per person are allowed.
- Check-in time at the hotel on the day of arrival depends on each establishment, but in no case will it be before 3:00 p.m., unless otherwise indicated.
- The most appropriate inter-island transport shall be arranged, weather permitting.
- The order of the itinerary may be altered for logistical reasons, without prior notice, but no scheduled trips will be cancelled (except in the case that adverse weather conditions prevent its realisation).
- A credit card is considered a guarantee, so sometimes you will need one for check-in at hotels.
- Prices are calculated based on admission fees to the sights as of the date of publication. If there is an increase in these prices, you will be promptly informed.
- If you are a person with reduced mobility, please contact us to confirm the suitability of the trip.
- Consult the necessary documentation to enter the destinations visited and for transit in the countries where air stopovers are made.
