DAY 1 · CITY OF ORIGIN - CAIRO

Day 1: Departure with destination Cairo. Arrival and assistance. Transfer to hotel. Check-in and overnight stay.

DAY 2 · CAIRO - LUXOR

Includes : Breakfast - Dinner

Day 2: Breakfast at hotel. Morning visit to the Pyramids, the Valley Temple and the Great Sphinx (without access to any pyramids). Return to hotel. In the afternoon, transfer at the prearranged time to take flight to Luxor. Arrival. Boarding, dinner and night on board in Luxor.

DAY 3 · LUXOR - ESNA - EDFU

Includes : Breakfast - Lunch - Dinner

Day 3: Full-board basis. Morning departure to visit the temples of Luxor and Karnak. Cruise towards Edfu via the Esna lock. Dinner and night on board in Edfu.

DAY 4 · EDFU - KOM OMBO - ASWAN

Includes : Breakfast - Lunch - Dinner

Day 4: Full board. Morning visit to the Temple of Horus at Edfu and onward cruise to Kom Ombo. Afternoon visit to the Temple of Sobek and Haroeris. Onward cruise to Aswan. Dinner and night on board in Aswan.

● DAYS 5-6 · ASWAN

Includes : Breakfast - Lunch - Dinner - Breakfast - Lunch - Dinner

Day 5: Full board. Visit to the High Dam. Felucca cruise in the afternoon. Dinner and night on board in Aswan.

Day 6: Full board. Day at your leisure with optional excursion to Abu Simbel. Return to the boat. Night on board in Aswan.

● DAY 7 · ASWAN - KOM OMBO - EDFU

Includes : Breakfast - Dinner

Day 7: Breakfast on the boat. Morning at your leisure in Aswan. Departure to Kom Ombo and onward cruise to Edfu. Dinner and night on board in Edfu.

● DAY 8 · EDFU - ESNA - LUXOR

Includes : Breakfast - Lunch - Dinner

Day 8: Full board. Day at your leisure for optional activities. Night on board in Luxor.

● DAY 9 · LUXOR - CAIRO

Includes : Breakfast

Day 9: Breakfast on board. Departure to visit the Valley of the Kings, the Temple of Habu Medinet and the Colossi of Menmon. In the afternoon, airport transfer for flight to Cairo. Arrival, transfer to hotel and overnight stay.

Days 10-11: Breakfast at hotel. Morning at your leisure for optional activities. Return to hotel and overnight stay.

Important remarks

- Egypt is a Muslim country and the month of Ramadan is of major significance to its residents. During Ramadan, entertainment and alcohol will be restricted in most of the country. The sale of alcohol will be restricted in many places, although some establishments will offer alcohol for sale to tourists. During this period, local businesses may also have shorter opening hours.
- The tours include cultural stops at local workshops so you can learn about the production of traditional crafts.
- Mandatory payments and optional excursions are payable in cash once in Egypt.
- Triple rooms in Africa are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far as possible.
- Check-in time at the hotel on the day of arrival depends on each establishment, but in no case will it be before 3:00 p.m., unless otherwise indicated.
- Check-in at hotels is from 12 p.m.
- Mandatory payments at destination (service fees and/or general tips) must be paid in cash.
- Cruise on the Nile: The category that we publish corresponds to the official categorization of the authority of the Ministry of Tourism of Egypt. However, this category does not correspond, in most cases, to European quality standards.
- The order of the itinerary may be altered for logistical reasons, without prior notice, but no scheduled trips will be cancelled (except in the case that adverse weather conditions prevent its realisation).
- A credit card is considered a guarantee, so sometimes you will need one for check-in at hotels.
- Prices are calculated based on admission fees to the sights as of the date of publication. If there is an increase in these prices, you will be promptly informed.

- If you are a person with reduced mobility, please contact us to confirm the suitability of the trip.
- Consult the necessary documentation to enter the destinations visited and for transit in the countries where air stopovers are made.
