



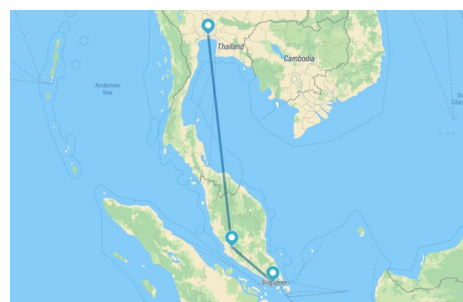

#### ● DAYS 1 - 4 · BANGKOK

Day 3: Bangkok. Free day. Overnight stay.

Day 4: Bangkok. Free day. Overnight stay.

#### ● DAYS 5 - 6 · KUALA LUMPUR

Day 5: Bangkok - Kuala Lumpur. Transfer to the airport by your own account. Flight from Bangkok to Kuala Lumpur. Arrival and transfer from the airport to the selected hotel in Kuala Lumpur by your own account. Free time. Overnight stay.

Day 6: Kuala Lumpur. Free day. Overnight stay.

#### ● DAYS 7 - 9 · SINGAPORE ISLAND

Day 7: Kuala Lumpur - Singapore Island. Transfer to the airport by your own account. Flight from Kuala Lumpur to Singapore Island. Arrival and transfer from the airport to the selected hotel in Singapore Island by your own account. Free time. Overnight stay.

Day 8: Singapore Island. Free day. Overnight stay.

Day 9: Singapore Island - City of origin. Transfer to the airport by your own account. Flight with destination the city of origin. Arrival. End of the trip and our services.

## Important remarks

- Triple rooms in Thailand are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far the possible.
- Please check with your international vaccination centre about the recommended healthcare measures in Thailand.
- The law in Thailand only allows entry into the country with one carton of tobacco per person.
- Depending on the return flight, the trip may be one day longer.
- Triple rooms in Asia are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far the possible.

- Check-in time at the hotel on the day of arrival depends on each establishment, but in no case will it be before 3:00 p.m., unless otherwise indicated.
- Triple rooms in Malaysia are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far as possible.
- Please check with your international vaccination centre about the recommended healthcare measures in Malaysia.
- Malaysia is a Muslim country and the month of Ramadan is of major significance to its residents. During Ramadan, entertainment and alcohol will be restricted in most of the country. The sale of alcohol will be restricted in many places, although some establishments will offer alcohol for sale to tourists. During this period, local businesses may also have shorter opening hours.
- Triple rooms in Singapore are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far as possible.
- Please check with your international vaccination centre about the recommended healthcare measures in Singapore.
- A credit card is considered a guarantee, so sometimes you will need one for check-in at hotels.
- Hotels usually have cots available. Otherwise, babies will have to share a bed with an adult.
- Consult the necessary documentation to enter the destinations visited and for transit in the countries where air stopovers are made.
