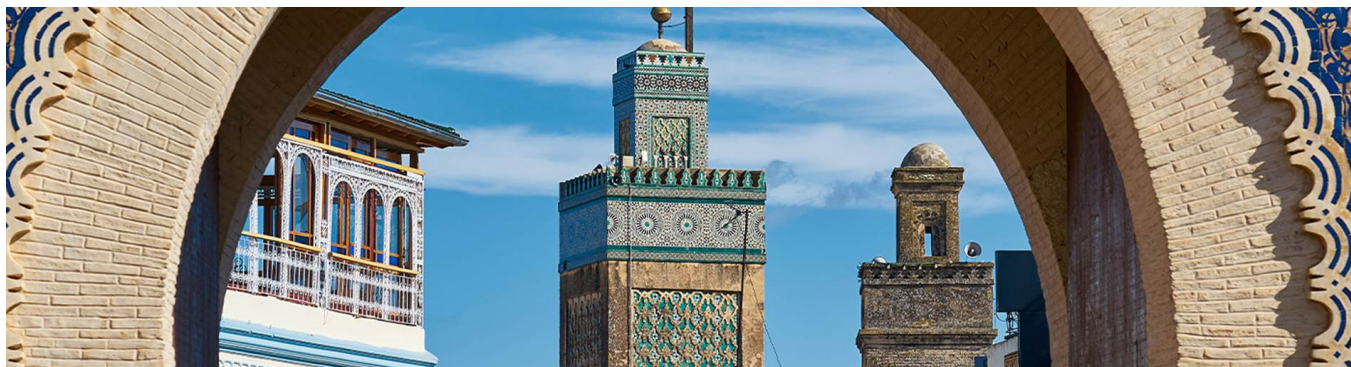




Morocco, 9 Days · Private tour

Travel details

DAY 1 · CITY OF ORIGIN - CASABLANCA

Day 1: Departure with destination Casablanca. Upon arrival at Casablanca airport, meet & greet with your driver and private transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day free. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Casablanca.

DAY 2 · CASABLANCA - RABAT

Includes : Breakfast - Dinner

Day 2: Breakfast. Start your day with an early visit to the amazing Casablanca. The city is the economical capital and the biggest city of Morocco. Visit the Classy Anfa Palace and the Hassan 2 Mosque. The city presents the modernity of Moroccan culture. Later on, continue to Rabat, the capital of the country and one of the amazing imperial cities. Visit the Kasbah of Oudayas, the Hassan Tower and the ruins of 200 columns, the Chellah Necropolis and the Mohammed V Mausoleum. Dinner and overnight stay in Rabat.

DAY 3 · RABAT - CHEFCHAOUEN

Includes : Breakfast - Dinner

Day 3: After breakfast, departure to Chefchaouen, the famous blue city of Morocco. Known for its blue-painted walls and charming relaxing atmosphere, this town was founded in 1471 AD. Today you will discover the magic of this photogenic population. Dinner and overnight stay.

● DAY 4 · CHEFCHAOUEN - MEKNES - FES

Includes : Breakfast - Dinner

Day 4: After breakfast, departure to Fes via Ouazzan and the Roman villa of Volubilis. After a couple of hours, arrival at Volubilis, an ancient Roman city that remains well preserved and dates back to 225 BC. Here you can see the best mosaics in Morocco dating from the 3rd century BC. Next, departure to Meknes, the Ismaili capital of Morocco. In Meknes, you can see the fascinating Ban Mansour gate, built by Sultan My Ismail; the granary and the Sahrij Souani, formerly used for planting and irrigation. In addition, the mausoleum of Mulay Ismail will be visited. Continuation to Fes. Dinner and overnight stay.

● DAY 5 · FES

Includes : Breakfast - Dinner

Day 5: Breakfast. In the morning, enjoy a cultural visit to the medina of Fes with the local guide. This city that once was the capital of Morocco is still considered the heart of Moroccan culture. The old medina of Fes is part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site. Walk through the old alleys of the medina and the most interesting places in the old town. Free afternoon. Dinner and overnight stay in a riad.

● DAY 6 · FES - BENI MELLAL - MARRAKESH

Includes : Breakfast

Day 6: After breakfast, departure to Marrakesh crossing the Middle Atlas mountains. En route, you will visit Ifrane, a city that houses the American University built by the Saudis. Following the road through Azrou and Khenfira, you come across Beni Mellal, a small town surrounded by orange and olive plantations. Beni Mellal is located at the foot of the Middle Atlas mountains, on the edge of the great Tadla plain, where a large amount of cereals are grown. The city has an interesting history as it has been inhabited by the Berber and Jewish people before the arrival of Islam. Continuation of the tour and arrival in Marrakesh in the early afternoon. The rest of the day is free. Overnight stay.

● DAY 7 · MARRAKESH

Includes : Breakfast

Day 7: Breakfast. Welcome to the largest cultural and tourist center in Morocco. Today you will explore what is known as the red city. You will start with a cultural visit of the old town with a local guide. The Medina of Marrakesh has been part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site for more than 30 years. You will stroll through the old souks (markets) and the streets of the medina. Free afternoon. Overnight stay in Marrakesh.

● DAY 8 · MARRAKESH - CASABLANCA

Includes : Breakfast - Dinner

Day 8: Breakfast. Departure to Casablanca. Arrival and rest of the day free . Dinner and overnight stay.

● DAY 9 · CASABLANCA - CITY OF ORIGIN

Day 9: Breakfast. Transfer to the airport. Flight with destination the city of origin. Arrival. End of the trip and our services.

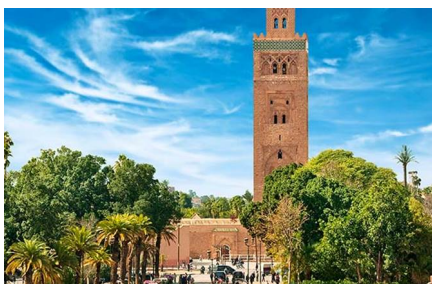

Important remarks

- Morocco is a Muslim country and the month of Ramadan is of major significance to its residents. During Ramadan, entertainment and alcohol will be restricted in most of the country. The sale of alcohol will be restricted in many places, although some establishments will offer alcohol for sale to tourists. During this period, local businesses may also have shorter opening hours.

- The tours include cultural stops at local workshops so you can learn about the production of traditional crafts.

- Triple rooms in Africa are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far as possible.

- Check-in time at the hotel on the day of arrival depends on each establishment, but in no case will it be before 3:00 p.m., unless otherwise indicated.
- Accommodation will always be in riads, with the exception of Casablanca where accommodation will be in a hotel.
- The order of the itinerary may be altered for logistical reasons, without prior notice, but no scheduled trips will be cancelled (except in the case that adverse weather conditions prevent its realisation).
- A credit card is considered a guarantee, so sometimes you will need one for check-in at hotels.
- Prices are calculated based on admission fees to the sights as of the date of publication. If there is an increase in these prices, you will be promptly informed.
- If you are a person with reduced mobility, please contact us to confirm the suitability of the trip.
- Consult the necessary documentation to enter the destinations visited and for transit in the countries where air stopovers are made.
