DAY 1 · CITY OF ORIGIN - CASABLANCA

Day 1: Departure with destination Casablanca. Upon arrival at Casablanca airport, meet & greet with your driver and private transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day free. Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel in Casablanca.

DAY 2 · CASABLANCA - RABAT

Includes : Breakfast - Dinner

Day 2: Breakfast. Start your day with an early visit to the amazing Casablanca. The city is the economical capital and the biggest city of Morocco. Visit the Classy Anfa Palace and the Hassan 2 Mosque. The city presents the modernity of Moroccan culture. Later on, continue to Rabat, the capital of the country and one of the amazing imperial cities. Visit the Kasbah of Oudayas, the Hassan Tower and the ruins of 200 columns, the Chellah Necropolis and the Mohamed V Mausoleum. Dinner and overnight stay in Rabat.

DAY 3 · RABAT - MEKNES - FES

Includes : Breakfast - Dinner

Day 3: After breakfast, departure to Meknes, one of the imperial cities of Morocco. Upon arrival, visit to the Bâb El Khamis, next to the old Mellah of Meknes (Jewish neighborhood); walk in the alleys of the medina that lead to the Great Mosque; and visit the Mausoleum of Moulay Ismail, a must in Meknes and one of the few religious monuments in Morocco that is accessible to non-Muslims. Later on, departure towards Volubili to visit one of the most amazing Roman ruins that witness the great history of Morocco. Continuation to Fes, dinner and overnight stay.

● DAY 4 · FES

Includes : Breakfast - Dinner

Day 4: Breakfast. In the morning, enjoy a cultural visit to the medina of Fes with the local guide. This city that once was the capital of Morocco is still considered the heart of Moroccan culture. The old medina of Fes is part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site. Walk through the old alleys of the medina and the most interesting places in the old town. Free afternoon. Dinner and overnight stay in a riad.

● DAY 5 · FES - AZROU - ERG CHEBBI

Includes : Breakfast - Dinner

Day 5: Breakfast. Morning departure from Fes to reach the Sahara desert. Today you will go through several landscapes, the Middle Atlas Mountains and the Ziz Valley. Arrival in Erg Chebbi, dinner and overnight stay.

● DAY 6 · ERG CHEBBI - KHAMLIA - MERZOUGA

Includes : Breakfast - Dinner

Day 6: After breakfast, you will explore the Sahara desert, its sand dunes, and its surroundings. Your day in the desert will include the Gnawa music show in Khamilia. In the afternoon, camel ride to the camp where you will spend the night, and where you can enjoy the sunset over the dunes, a campfire and the stars. Dinner and overnight stay in a deluxe camp.

● DAY 7 · MERZOUGA - DADES GORGES - OUARZAZATE

Includes : Breakfast - Dinner

Day 7: Complete your stay in the desert watching the sunrise over the dunes. After breakfast, departure to Ouarzazate passing the Todra gorges, where you will climb to almost 300 meters from the top. Lush river valleys provide the perfect setting for the drive to southeastern Morocco. Marvel at the splendor of the natural beauty of Morocco in the Dades Gorges crossing the impressive rock formations, the road of 100 kasbahs and the Oasis of Skoura. Arrival in Ouarzazate. Dinner and overnight stay.

● DAY 8 · OUARZAZATE - AIT BENHADDOU - MARRAKESH

Includes : Breakfast

Day 8: Breakfast. Welcome to the Hollywood of Africa. You will start the day by visiting the center of Ouarzazate, El Taourit, the Oasis Fint and the film studios. This city is famous for the large number of movies that have been shot here, such as Gladiator, Babel or many others. After the visit, continue to Ait Benhaddou, an impressive kasbah that is part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site. Continuation to Marrakesh crossing the Atlas Mountains and the Tizi N'Tichka pass of 2260 meters of altitude, this being the link between the two cities. Arrival in Marrakesh and overnight stay.

● DAY 9 · MARRAKESH

Includes : Breakfast

Day 9: Breakfast. Welcome to the largest cultural and tourist center in Morocco. Today you will explore what is known as the red city. You will start with a cultural visit of the old town with a local guide. The Medina of Marrakesh has been part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site for more than 30 years. You will stroll through the old souks (markets) and the streets of the medina. Free afternoon. Overnight stay in Marrakesh.

● DAY 10 · MARRAKESH - CASABLANCA

Includes : Breakfast - Dinner

Day 10: Breakfast. Departure to Casablanca. Arrival and rest of the day free . Dinner and overnight stay.

● DAY 11 · CASABLANCA - CITY OF ORIGIN

Includes : Breakfast

Day 11: Breakfast. Transfer to the airport. Flight with destination the city of origin. Arrival. End of the trip and our services.

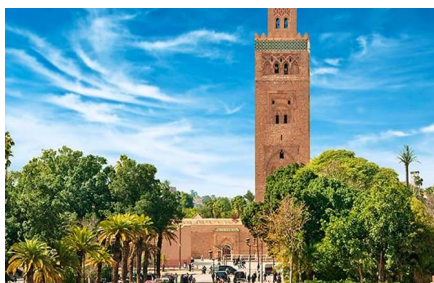

Important remarks

- Morocco is a Muslim country and the month of Ramadan is of major significance to its residents. During Ramadan, entertainment and alcohol will be restricted in most of the country. The sale of alcohol will be restricted in many places, although some establishments will offer alcohol for sale to tourists. During this period, local businesses may also have shorter opening hours.
- The tours include cultural stops at local workshops so you can learn about the production of traditional crafts.
- Triple rooms in Africa are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far the possible.
- Check-in time at the hotel on the day of arrival depends on each establishment, but in no case will it be before 3:00 p.m., unless otherwise indicated.
- Accommodation will always be in riads, with the exception of Casablanca where accommodation will be in a hotel.
- Children under 12 are not accepted.
- The order of the itinerary may be altered for logistical reasons, without prior notice, but no scheduled trips will be cancelled (except in the case that adverse weather conditions prevent its realisation).
- A credit card is considered a guarantee, so sometimes you will need one for check-in at hotels.
- Prices are calculated based on admission fees to the sights as of the date of publication. If there is an increase in these prices, you will be promptly informed.
- If you are a person with reduced mobility, please contact us to confirm the suitability of the trip.
- Consult the necessary documentation to enter the destinations visited and for transit in the countries where air stopovers are made.
