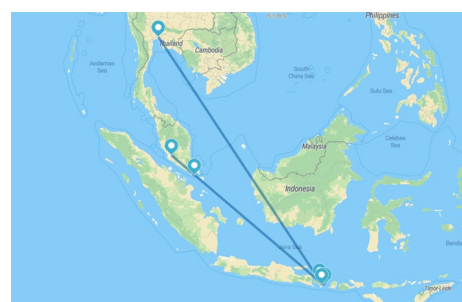
Kuala Lumpur, Singapore, Bali and Bangkok

Malaysia's capital, Kuala Lumpur, is the country's largest city and one of the most modern in Southeast Asia. Skyscrapers, suspended monorail systems and other state-of-the-art public transport systems share the same skyline with an exquisite colonial centre of low-rise houses, old cars, street stalls and heavy traffic.

Cruising the Singapore River by boat, eating at a hawker, seeing the skyscrapers from Merlion Park, visiting Little India, walking through Chinatown and having a drink at Clarke Quay are just some of the experiences you can have in Singapore.

This classic itinerary takes you through the most important points of an island that, for many, is a paradise in Southeast Asia: the temples of Tanah Lot, Ulun Danu and Besakih; rice terraces and waterfalls that break the silence; enclosures that centuries ago were used to impart justice or pay homage to the ancestors... And all of this surrounded by impressive landscapes where the green hardly loses its prominence.

In Bangkok, take in the most authentic Asia, marvel at the magnificence of its traditional architecture, immerse yourself in its spirituality, enjoy its gastronomy and discover how the night awakens travelling on a river cruise.

● DAY 1 · CITY OF ORIGIN - KUALA LUMPUR

Day 1: Departure with destination Kuala Lumpur. Night on board.

● DAYS 2-4 · KUALA LUMPUR

Day 2: Arrival and transfer from the airport to the selected hotel in Kuala Lumpur by your own account. Free time. Overnight stay.

Days 3-4: Free day. Overnight stay.

● DAY 5 · KUALA LUMPUR - SINGAPORE ISLAND

Day 5: Transfer to the airport by your own account. Flight from Kuala Lumpur to Singapore Island. Arrival and transfer from the airport to the selected hotel in Singapore Island. Free time. Overnight stay.

● DAY 6 · SINGAPORE ISLAND

Day 6: Free day. Overnight stay.

● DAY 7 · SINGAPORE ISLAND - BALI ISLAND

Day 7: At the scheduled time, transfer to the airport. Flight from Singapore Island to Bali Island. Arrival and transfer from the airport to the selected hotel in Bali Island. Free time. Overnight stay.

● DAY 8 · LOVINA

Includes : Lunch

Day 8: Departure to Lovina. On the way, we'll visit the temple of Tanah Lot. After this stop, we'll continue north via Alas Kedaton to visit the monkey forest. The next stop will be in Bedugul, where we'll visit the Pura Ulun Danu temple on Lake Beratan. The temple stands 1,200 metres above sea level. Lunch included. The last visit before arriving in Lovina will be to the 45-metre-high Gitgit Waterfall. The sound of the waterfall can be heard from two hundred metres away. Arrival in Lovina. Transfer to hotel. Accommodation.

● DAY 9 · LOVINA - CANDIDASA

Includes : Breakfast - Lunch

Day 9: Breakfast. Morning departure to Candidasa. En route, we'll stop off at the traditional Buleleng market. Afterwards, we'll visit the temple of Pura Beji, dedicated to the goddess Dewi Sri, protector of the rice fields. We'll then continue to Kintamani, where, weather permitting, we can admire a fantastic view of Mount Batur, an active volcano. Lunch at a local restaurant. Visit to Besakih Temple, the largest and most important temple on the island of Bali. It was built in the eleventh century on the slopes of Mount Agung, a sacred volcano. Onward journey to Candidasa. Arrival and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation.

● DAY 10 · CANDIDASA - UBUD

Includes : Breakfast - Lunch

Day 10: Breakfast. Departure to Goa Lawah, a temple built in a cave inhabited by bats. We'll then continue towards Sidemen and its landscapes of rice terraces. Lunch at a local restaurant. The next stop will be Klung Kung, where we'll visit Kertagosa Palace, which features traditional Balinese architecture and was once the seat of the Court of Justice. The last visit of the day will be to Gunung Kawi, a temple and funerary complex from the eleventh century. Arrival in Ubud. Transfer to hotel. Accommodation.

● DAY 11 · UBUD - BALI ISLAND

Includes : Breakfast

Day 11: Breakfast. Free time until transfer time. Arrival. Overnight stay.

● DAYS 12-13 · BALI ISLAND

Days 12-13: Free day. Overnight stay.

● DAY 14 · BALI ISLAND - BANGKOK

Day 14: At the scheduled time, transfer to the airport. Flight from Bali Island to Bangkok. Arrival and transfer from the airport to the selected hotel in Bangkok by your own account. Free time. Overnight stay.

● DAYS 15-16 · BANGKOK

Days 15-16: Free day. Overnight stay.

● DAY 17 · BANGKOK - CITY OF ORIGIN

Day 17: Transfer to the airport by your own account. Flight to City of origin destination. Night on board.

● DAY 18 · CITY OF ORIGIN

Day 18: Arrival. End of the trip and our services.

The sale of alcohol will be restricted in many places, although some establishments will offer alcohol for sale to tourists. During this period, local businesses may also have shorter opening hours.
- To reconfirm services at the destination, please send us your passport details within 24 hours of booking.
- Triple rooms in Asia are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far the possible.
- Check-in time at the hotel on the day of arrival depends on each establishment, but in no case will it be before 3:00 p.m., unless otherwise indicated.
- Triple rooms in Singapore are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far the possible.
- Please check with your international vaccination centre about the recommended healthcare measures in Singapore.
- Depending on the return flight, the trip may be one day longer.

accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far the possible.

- The baggage allowance on domestic flights of most airlines in India is usually 15 kg per person, so lower than on international flights. Please take account of this when packing your bags.

- Indonesia is a Muslim country and the month of Ramadan is of major significance to its residents. During Ramadan, entertainment and alcohol will be restricted in most of the country. The sale of alcohol will be restricted in many places, although some establishments will offer alcohol for sale to tourists. During this period, local businesses may also have shorter opening hours.

- Children up to 11 years old will not have their own bed or cot, so they will sleep in the bed provided with the adults.

- Triple rooms in Thailand are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far the possible.

- Please check with your international vaccination centre about the recommended healthcare measures in Thailand.

- The law in Thailand only allows entry into the country with one carton of tobacco per person.

- Many hotels in Thailand offer special touches for travellers on their honeymoon. If this is your case and you've decided to put the most important journey of your life in our hands, then you're in luck. Let us know that it's your honeymoon when you book and don't forget to take documentation proving your recent marriage (certificate or original invitation) along with your travel documents. This is because the hotels offering these special touches will ask to see it.

- The order of the itinerary may be altered for logistical reasons, without prior notice, but no scheduled trips will be cancelled (except in the case that adverse weather conditions prevent its realisation).

- A credit card is considered a guarantee, so sometimes you will need one for check-in at hotels.
