



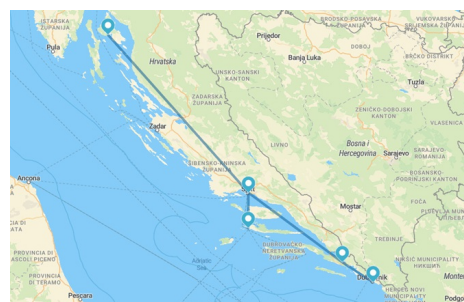
Croatia, 7 Days · Private tour

DAY 1 · CITY OF ORIGIN - SPLIT

Day 1: Departure with destination Split. Arrival and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation.

DAY 2 · SPLIT

Includes : Breakfast

Day 2: After breakfast, short transfer from the hotel to the historic center of Split. Walking tour of Split, a UNESCO World Heritage city, built within the ancient palace of Emperor Diocletian. After the visit, free time to stroll along the Riva promenade, shop for local handicrafts, or relax in one of the charming cafés. Return to the hotel on your own. Accommodation.

DAY 3 · SPLIT – KRKA NATIONAL PARK – SPLIT

Includes : Breakfast

Day 3: Breakfast. Full-day excursion to Krka National Park, one of Croatia's most impressive natural attractions, discovering its network of scenic trails, wooden walkways, and spectacular waterfalls. Visit to the famous Skradinski Buk waterfalls area. Free time to enjoy the views, take photographs, or relax in a peaceful natural setting before returning to Split in the afternoon. Accommodation.

● DAY 4 · SPLIT – HVAR – SPLIT

Includes : Breakfast

Day 4: After breakfast, transfer to the port of Split to board a catamaran to the island of Hvar. Free time to explore the charming old town of Hvar, its elegant harbor, and the hilltop fortress offering panoramic views of the Adriatic Sea. In the afternoon, return to Split by catamaran and transfer back to the hotel. Accommodation.

● DAY 5 · SPLIT – OYSTER EXPERIENCE IN STON – DUBROVNIK

Includes : Breakfast

Day 5: Breakfast. Departure south along the picturesque Adriatic coastline towards Dubrovnik. En route, stop in Ston, a medieval town famous for its ancient walls and oyster farms. Oyster tasting directly over the water, accompanied by local wine. Continue on to Dubrovnik. Accommodation.

● DAY 6 · DUBROVNIK

Includes : Breakfast

Day 6: After breakfast, short transfer from the hotel to Pile Gate, the main entrance to Dubrovnik's old town. Walking tour of this magnificent UNESCO World Heritage city. Return to the hotel on your own. Accommodation.

● DAY 7 · DUBROVNIK - CITY OF ORIGIN

Includes : Breakfast

Day 7: Breakfast and transfer to the airport. Flight with destination the city of origin. Arrival. End of the trip and our services.

Important remarks

- Babies up to 2 years old in Croatia must share the bed with adults. In case you need a cot, or any other additional service, you will have to request it at each hotel and it will be a direct payment.
- Triple rooms in Europe are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far as possible.
- During congresses and special events, the confirmed hotels and other accommodations may be different to those indicated.
- During the circuit by Europe, only one suitcase and one carry-on bag per person are allowed.
- Check-in time at the hotel on the day of arrival depends on each establishment, but in no case will it be before 3:00 p.m., unless otherwise indicated.
- The order of the itinerary may be altered for logistical reasons, without prior notice, but no scheduled trips will be cancelled (except in the case that adverse weather conditions prevent its realisation).
- A credit card is considered a guarantee, so sometimes you will need one for check-in at hotels.
- Prices are calculated based on admission fees to the sights as of the date of publication. If there is an increase in these prices, you will be promptly informed.
- If you are a person with reduced mobility, please contact us to confirm the suitability of the trip.
- Consult the necessary documentation to enter the destinations visited and for transit in the countries where air stopovers are made.
