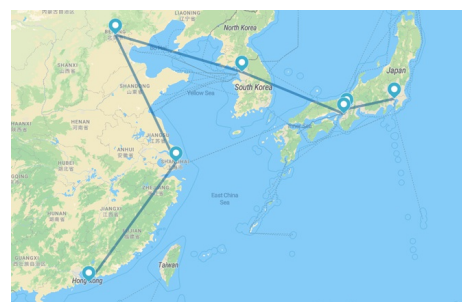

Capital of Japan between the eighth and nineteenth centuries, Kyoto proudly hosts an exceptional and diverse legacy in the fields of arts, culture, religion and thinking. Each step will take you to a new architectural treasure in the form of a castle, palace, temple, sanctuary or garden. Among all this architectural wealth, highlights include the sumptuous Nijo Castle, residence of the shogun Tokugawa Ieyasu; the 1,001 gilded wooden statues of the Sanjusangendo Temple; the temples of Kiyomizu, Ryoanji, Ginkakuji (Silver Pavilion) and Kinkakuji (Golden Pavilion); and the Katsura Imperial Villa, one of the finest examples of Japanese architecture. Don't miss the Gion neighbourhood, the ideal place to discover 'Kabuki' theatre, traditional arts such as floral arranging, and the 'Maiko', whose ornate appearance is the stereotype of the geisha for Westerners. A clear example is Seoul, its magnificent capital, where the modernity and tradition of South Korea can be appreciated in many of its corners. Thanks to its efficient metro system, the tourist can move around the city with great ease and visit, among other attractions, the tsunami-shaped City Hall, and opposite it Deoksugung Palace; the wonderful palaces of the Changdeokgung complex, declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site; Gyeongbokgung Palace, with 600 years of history behind it; and the Lotte World Tower, an impressive building 550 meters high. The Myeongdong district (meaning bright tunnel) is the largest commercial and lifestyle area in South Korea, while Bukchon Hanok Village is the traditional historic district dotted with small houses. A must-see is the War Memorial, a museum that reviews the conflicts experienced in the region throughout history, such as the various Chinese and Japanese invasions and the Korean War of the last century.

During the visit to Beijing, you will be able to enter the Forbidden City, the fortress from which the emperors ruled for more than 500 years, and other historical places such as the Summer Palace and the Temple of Heaven. Beijing is also the ideal starting point to discover one of the Seven Wonders of the World, the Great Wall of China.

In Shanghai, the contrast between the old, such as the Yuyuan Garden, and the cutting-edge architecture of the Pudong district will transport you into a setting that immerses you in an astonishing and fascinating reality...

Hong Kong is one of the economic motors of China and its most modern city. Hong Kong is a city that never sleeps, a city with dozens of entertainment and cultural sites, with dozens of markets and street markets, and a skyline that leaves cities like New York behind.

## Important remarks

---

- Triple rooms in Japan are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far the possible.
- Please check with your international vaccination centre about the recommended healthcare measures in Japan.
- Depending on the return flight, the trip may be one day longer.
- In general, people with tattoos are not accepted in the onsen for cultural reasons. If they're small tattoos, they could be covered with a plaster, but access isn't guaranteed if the tattoos are large.
- **VERY IMPORTANT REGARDING THE JAPAN RAIL PASS:** you can access purchase options and all relevant information on the website: <http://www.jrpass.com>. The Japan Rail Pass cannot be purchased more than three months prior to the date of the first train journey.

- Check-in time at the hotel on the day of arrival depends on each establishment, but in no case will it be before 3:00 p.m., unless otherwise indicated.

- Triple rooms in China are generally rooms with twin beds or a double, in which a folding bed is installed to

accommodate the third person. Due to the inconvenience this causes, we advise against using this option as far the possible.

- Please check with your international vaccination centre about the recommended healthcare measures in China.
- On domestic train journeys within China, regulations stipulate that only one spray with a maximum capacity of 100 ml may be carried in luggage.
- In China, with regard to external batteries (powerbanks), whether travelling by train or by plane, it is mandatory that they are certified under the CCC (China Compulsory Certification) in order to be allowed on board.
- A credit card is considered a guarantee, so sometimes you will need one for check-in at hotels.
- Hotels usually have cots available. Otherwise, babies will have to share a bed with an adult.
- Consult the necessary documentation to enter the destinations visited and for transit in the countries where air stopovers are made.
